## **AFN 2008 Conference Scholarship Application**

The AFN (Australasian Facilitators' Network) supports the mission of the IAF (International Association of Facilitators) to promote, support and advance the art and practice of professional facilitation through methods exchange, professional growth, practical research, collegial networking and support services.

An important means of achieving this is via the annual AFN Conference – one of the many global IAF conferences.

The AFN is pleased to offer a number of scholarships – especially for, but not limited to, international and interregional participants, including voluntary and community-based practitioners, students, and others who may otherwise have difficulty in attending the AFN Conference.

Eligible persons include those who meet any of the following 'disadvantage' criteria:

- people who are on a low income
- people who live a great distance from the conference venue
- people who are only just starting out as facilitators
- facilitators who operate primarily in the non-profit sector
- Indigenous Australians or Māori people, particularly those working in remote locations
- persons from developing countries or countries in transition in south-east Asia or the Pacific.

In most cases, scholarship support covers full conference registration costs only, and does not include the cost of transport, pre- or post-conference workshops, accommodation, and other personal expenses.

Some applicants may be eligible for a higher level of support. This will be assessed on an individual basis, drawing on information provided in the application process.

A scholarship holder may be requested to assist during the conference with aspects of administration or event management. Conditions may be imposed on the scholarship provision.

## **Application Process**

Deadline for application is 29 June 2008.

Applicants will be notified of the outcome by 31 July.

Applicants must acknowledge acceptance of a scholarship and any conditions by 14 August 2008

Applications will be considered by a panel drawn from the Conference Organising Team.
